1. The P&D Department of AJK has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the “Disaster & Climate Resilience Improvement Project (DCRIP) IDA Cr. No. 5686-PK, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for “*Restoration of Flood Protection Structures of Package-1 (PP&H) at Bandi Bagh near Nisar Camp, Chehla Bandi at Right Bank Neelum River, District Muzaffarabad.*”
2. The Physical Planning & Housing (PP&H) GoAJK in collaboration with the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) DCRIP now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the following package;

3. The completion period for contract is ten **(10 months)**.

Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank’s [\*Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers January 2011 revised July 2014\*](#) (“Procurement Guidelines”), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs **1.6 and 1.7** setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from PIU-DCRIP and can inspect the bidding documents during office hours **09:00 Hrs to 16:00 Hrs** at the address given below.
6. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application on the company letter head along with the company authorization letter of representative, to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of PKR 6,000/-. The method of payment will be “Pay Order” in favor of Project Director PIU-DCRIP or cash deposit. The documents are to be collected by hand.
7. A Pre-bid Meeting will be held on **October 25, 2017 at 11:00 Hrs** on the address given below for the purpose of clarifying issues and answering questions on the Bidding Documents. Representatives of potential Bidders may choose to attend.
8. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **November 09, 2017 at 11:00 Hrs**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below **on same date at 11:30 Hrs**.
9. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security as mentioned in **Para 2** above.
